General Supplementary Regulations

To be read in conjunction with the Race Meeting Standing Regulations as contained in the 2016 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. The meeting will be held on Saturday 24th & Sunday 25th September 2016 at Morgan Park Raceway, Warwick, Qld. This circuit is a 3.00km hot mix asphalt track. Production Sports may also use the 2.1km circuit, providing they have practiced and qualified on this circuit. Track direction is clockwise. This Multi Club meeting shall be promoted and organised by the Warwick District Sporting Car Club. PO Box 16, Warwick, Qld 4370.

1. Administration

The meeting shall be known as the 2016 Circuit Excel Nationals and shall be conducted under the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A. , the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the Race Meeting Standing Regulations in the current CAMS Manual, 2016 Circuit Excel Nationals Sporting Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations or bulletins as may be issued. 1.2 ABANDONMENT, CANCELLATION OR POSTPONEMENT OF EVENT

The event organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

1.3 ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS

Competitors must hold a current CAMS Level PC/PCC or higher licence for car events and must be members of a CAMS affiliated club. All entries must be accompanied by the Entry Fee or they will not be accepted.

Entries will be accepted for the following categories:

- Circuit Excel Cars (Group 3E)
- Production Sports Cars
- Geminis, HQ's and Saloon Cars complying with groups 3J, 3H and 3K respectively.

2. ENTRIES

2.1 Entries will be open on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and close on Saturday 10th September, 2016 (10 pm)
Entry fee will be \$300.00. This includes GST .

The maximum number of entries for this event may be limited to 250. Acceptance of entries will be in order of receipt and may be refused in

2.2 A minimum of 16 (sixteen) bona fide entries must be received from any category to be allocated a race on this programme, refer to Standing Regulation 2.4, NCR 169 (xvi) and NCR 172(xi) for change of programme.

2.3 A Change of driver may be permitted subject to NCR 143. Refer to Circuit Excel National Sporting Regulations S5.

3. DOCUMENT ADMINISTRATION & VEHICLE SCRUTINY

3.1 ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS ARE TO BE PRESENTED AND CHECKED AT THE EVENT SECRETARIES OFFICE PRIOR TO VEHICLE SCRUTINY. Log Books, Competition Licences/Passbooks and CAMS Club Membership Cards. Refer to NCR 67 (xxiv). All cars will be inspected for safety during the weekend. Target Scrutiny will be in operation.

3.2 Scrutiny will take place at the circuit starting at times to be advised in Further Regulations. Scrutiny may be extended at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

All driving apparel, including helmets and frontal head restraints, must be in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual and be presented with your car at scrutiny.

Any competing vehicles that are road registered in Queensland are required to have an extension to their Compulsory Third Party Insurance Certificate which must be presented at Event Secretaries Office.

Competitors Note:

AS OF 01/01/2015 ALL DRIVERS COMPETING IN CAMS STATE LEVEL & ABOVE RACING EVENTS MUST WEAR AN APPROVED FRONTAL HEAD RESTRAINT DURING ALL ACTIVITIES.

AS OF 01/01/2015 ALL VEHICLES COMPETING IN CAMS STATE LEVELS & ABOVE RACING EVENTS MUST BE FITTED WITH AN APPROVED FIVE (5) POINT OR SIX (6) POINT (TYPE A) SAFETY HARNESS

4. PRACTICE & QUALIFYING

4.1 Private practice will be available from approx. 8.30am till approx. 4.30pm on Friday 23rd September 2016 at the circuit. **Private practice is NOT included in entry fee payment, however Interstate Hyundai Excel Competitors will receive free private practice on Friday.**

Private practice will be organised by WDSCC. Payment to practice must be made on the day to WDSCC at old scrutineering shed prior to commencing practice.

4.2 Each nominated driver must complete at least (3) laps of practice/qualifying - Competitors attention is particularly drawn to details in Regulation 5.2 of the RACE MEETING Standing Regulations as contained in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

Qualifying will be held on Saturday the 24th September 2016 at times to be advised in Further Supplementary Regulations. If Drivers are unable to qualify in an allotted session, they may be permitted to run in another session, but only at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Qualifying out of session will not count for grid position.

5. RACING

5.1 All classes will have Massed Grid Starts

Cars for all races will assemble in the numbered bays in the marshalling area and on signal will move onto the track in single file for one (1) warm up lap before taking up their allocated position for a massed grid start. The starter will indicate approximately 5 seconds before the red lights are switched on. At a time between 3 and 5 seconds after the red light is shown, the start of the race will be indicated by the extinguishment of the red lights. A green light will not be shown. Refer RMSR.

Progressive grid starts may apply in some categories and these shall be advised in Further Regulations. Refer 2016 Circuit Excel National Sporting Regulations.

5.2 Signalling - Competitors are reminded that with the exception of the designated Signalling Area. (purely for signalling pit crew), pit lane is a prohibited area during all competition.

Children under the age of 16 (sixteen) are not allowed in pit lane during practice or competition.

5.3 Driving Standards Each driver shall comply with the Code of Driving Conduct of the Race Meeting Standing Regulations. Driving in an inappropriate manner (such as overly aggressive driving or drifting) may result in the driver being referred to the Stewards of the Meeting. Footage in Video Cameras must be made available, on request, to the Category Race Director or DSO.

6. GENERAL

6.1 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES - Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty (ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all the competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

6.2 It is a condition of entry that Competitors agree to pay all costs incurred by the Queensland Fire and Rescue Club for the use of firefighting equipment on their car.

6.3 All cars competing at Morgan Park Raceway must be silenced so that when monitored, the maximum noise level emission of any vehicle does not exceed 95dB(A) in the standard 30 metre run-by-test. Any car may not compete unless it meets this requirement.

6.4 Timing - : Timing will be by the **MyLaps** electronic system, and transponders will be available at the circuit from Timekeeping at no charge. **A refundable security deposit of \$100 cash is to be lodged on issue of the transponder and this will be refunded when it is returned at the end of the meeting. If the transponder is returned damaged, the \$100 deposit will be forfeited to cover costs of repair.**

7. Garages are available for hire for the weekend. Payment must be made on arrival to WDSCC at old scrutineering shed. Bookings must be made prior to the meeting with John Wishart on 0437471433 (call between 9am and 6pm only please) or email: morganparkraceway@westnet.com.au

8. Pit Lane Speed Limit – the pit lane speed limit shall be 40 kmh.

9. Insurance – Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. 10. Protests – Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

11. Fuel – Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Fuel will not be available at the circuit.

12. Power sites are available at \$20 per day and payable to WDSCC circuit owners on the weekend. The sites are all located near the 8 power poles behind (eastern side of) the lower level carports. NO RESERVATIONS ARE POSSIBLE. OH & S restricts the use of unprotected power leads on the ground and NO double adapters may be used.

13. Camping is allowed for competitors along the east side fence and north end of the main pit area but note that there is no power close to these areas. Cost is \$5.00 per person per day payable to the WDSCC circuit owners on the weekend.

14. Compulsory Drivers Briefing will be held on Saturday 24th September, 2016 at **8am** at the grandstand. All competitors will be required to sign an attendance sheet. Additional briefings may be held at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Failure to attend drivers briefing may result in a stewards hearing and a monetary fine.
